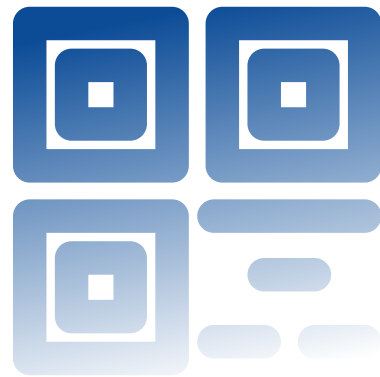
## SAE Sunday
